



## Quick Start Leads to Cavalier Victory

Special teams and the legs of Brody Hoying allowed Coldwater to jump out to a large halftime lead and the defense sealed the deal in the second half as the Cavaliers defeated the Minster Wildcats by a final score of 35-13.

Coldwater struck first taking their opening drive into the endzone as Hoying scored on a 13 yard run. Minster followed a three and out with a short punt which Drew Otten ran 51 yards to pay dirt. But the Cats regrouped and a short time later used a nine play drive to bring the score to 14-7 to end the first quarter.

The second quarter is one the Minster would like to forget. Adam Klosterman returned a punt 62 yards for a score and two minutes later Hoying scrambled from 31 yards out to press Coldwater's advantage to 28-7. Then with just two minutes remaining in the half Hoying scored again from 17 yards out to take the teams to the locker room with Coldwater leading 35-7.

The second half moved quickly as Minster opened the half with a 14 play drive deep into Coldwater territory but came up empty. Coldwater answered with 15 play drive of their own but also failed to score. The Cats put up a final score with 7 minutes to play but that was as close as they could get.

The final stats indicated a game which was much closer than the final score. Minster outgained Coldwater by 10 yards, 238-228, but the Cavalier defense stiffened inside the red zone.

Hoying put up some more big numbers on the evening as he tallied 292 yards of total offense, 144 yards on 14 carries for three touchdowns and 148 yards on 12 of 25 passing. Adam Klosterman caught three passes for 77 yards and turned his one

punt return into a 62 yard score. Drew Otten had a 51 yard punt return for a score. Matt Kremer continues to shine in the kicking game making all five of his extra point attempts and two of his six kickoffs resulted in touchbacks.

The win moves Coldwater to 4-1 overall and 3-0 in the MAC. They stand alone with Marion Local (5-0, 3-0) at the top of the MAC standings. Also, in the Harbin Standings, the Cavs moved up three spots into third place with five games to play.

### Next Up – The Backyard Battle

They call it the Backyard Battle, but for the last 16 years the battle has been rather lopsided. Coldwater has won the last 17 meeting including 2 victories in the 2009 season. During the steak Coldwater has won 3 overtime games and in the last nine regular season meetings the Cavaliers have held the Redskins to 7 points or less including three shut outs.

St. Henry enters this game with a 1-4 record having shutout New Bremen 42-0 last week under first year head coach Brad Luthman who won a state title as a player at Versailles and spent the last two seasons on Marion Local's staff. He inherited a team that returns two second team All-MAC players in senior RB Adam Reichert and senior DB Tyler Schwieterman.
