Cavaliers Dominate the Skins

The Coldwater Cavaliers continued their quest for an MAC title Friday night with a 35-6 victory over the St. Henry Redskins. Save for five penalties and a lost fumble, it was nearly a perfect night for the Cavs.

The offense had just six possession on the evening and scored on their first five. They rushed for 231 yards and threw for 174 in 43 plays, averaging over 9 yards per play.

The defense, which gave up a touchdown on the last play of the first half, allowed just 179 total yards, recovered two fumbles, intercepted one pass and stopped St. Henry on two trips into the red zone.

Brody Hoying and Adam Klosterman led the offensive charge for the Cavaliers. Hoying nearly had a perfect passing night, completing 10 of 11 passes for 174 yards and two touchdowns. But his most exciting plays were his rushing attempts. Hoying juke, stutter-stepped, bolted and sprinted his way to 136 yards on 10 carries and two more touchdowns. His most impressive run came on a 73 yard touchdown run on the opening possession of the third quarter to dash what ever hope St. Henry had at victory. Meanwhile Klosterman caught four of Hoying's passes for 98 yards and one score.

St. Henry shanked the punt on their opening possession give Coldwater the ball at their own 40 yard line. Coldwater moved to the one yard line in four plays, and it appear disaster struck as they fumbled the ball on their next play. But Matt Kremer reacted from his split end possession and recovered the ball in the end zone. He then added the PAT to put Coldwater up 7-0.

Mitch Schoenherr caught a 13 yard pass from Hoying on the first play of the second quarter to cap an 84 yard drive and the Cavs led 14-0. Late in the second Hoying scored on a 13 yard run to complete an 80 yard drive. After his 73 yard run to put Coldwater on top 28-6, Hoying found Klosterman on a 15 yard pass with just over 4 minutes to play to complete the scoring for the evening. Kremer was perfect on PATs, going 5 for 5.

Late in the game with the second string doing the mop up work, senior running back Nick Staughler had the best night of his career netting 46 yards on 8 carries including a hard fought 14 yard run for a much needed first down.

The win pushes Coldwater to 5-1 and 4-0 in the MAC. St. Henry drops to 1-5 and 1-3 in league play.

Next Up – Anna

Coldwater returns home next week to host the Anna Rockets. The Rockets have struggled to a 2-4 record and just one win in four MAC games. Last week they lost to Minster in a high scoring affair 41-34 as Minster completed an 85 yard pass play with just 1:46 left in the game to ground the Rockets.
