team speed, a good number of returning skill position players and an experienced kicking game lead by kicker Kyle McKibben and punter Ryan Griesdorn. He is concerned about the unproven talent of those who will be competing for positions on the O and D lines and about not having a returning long snapper which is key to a successful kicking game.

*"With 24 seniors returning we feel like we have the parts to be a League contender but we have many unproven players fighting for starting positions. Once again our schedule is a good one, playing 5 playoff teams from last year, 2 state champs (Minster and Marion Local), and a Final 4 Kenton team."*

#### A Little History...

Twenty years ago in 1995, Coldwater hired former Parkway Head Coach John Reed and thus began a

new winning tradition of football at Coldwater High School.

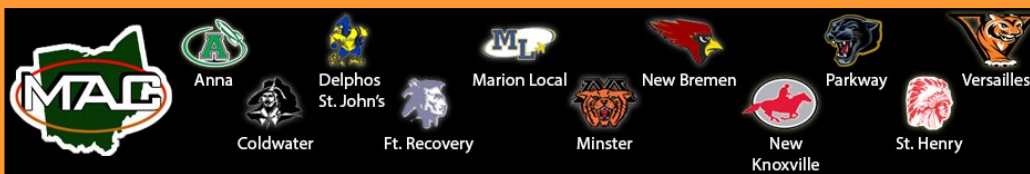
In those 20 season under the leadership of Reed and current Head Coach Chip Otten, the program has posted a record of 232-42, an 88% winning percentage. They have been to the playoffs all but one of those seasons (1996) where they have a record of 60-14 including 10 State Final appearances and 5 gold trophies.

This year is also the 10th anniversary of the Cavaliers first State Title. Since 2005 the Cavs have appeared in 8 title games including each of the last six seasons.

Since 2000 Coldwater has won more football games (187) than any program in the state of Ohio regardless of size.

In 2012 the Senior Class established a new OHSAA football record as they participated in 60 games in four years a feat never before attained. It has been duplicated by the Classes of 2013 and 2014 also.

Coldwater is a charter member of the mighty Midwest Athletic Conference which following then end of the 2014-15 school year has accumulated 114 State Championships including 28 in football. Last season the conference won THREE state titles - Coldwater, Marion Local and Minster.

A graduate of Coldwater High School, Chip Otten played quarterback under his father, Head Coach Barney Otten. He played college football at Bowling Green State University. Later he served as a graduate assistant at BGSU as well as at Ball State and Indiana University.

His 29 years of coaching experience include Head Coach from 1995-2000 at Middletown where he compiled a 26-34 (43%) record. He also served as an assistant at Middletown from 1987-1994 and at Valley View in 2001. He returned to

Coldwater as an assistant to John Reed in 2002.

2015 is Coach Otten's 6th as the Head Coach of the Cavaliers where his record is 64-11. He has won one MAC title, 5 Regional and 3 State Titles in five State Championship game appearances. Overall Coach Otten's records is 90-45.
